

New Braemar Prepayment Policy

Braemar is introducing a new prepayment program for 2021. Prepayment is required for Monday Stroke Play, Tuesday Match Play, Wednesday Match Play, and Thursday Stroke Play. Prepayment is not required for Saturday Stroke Play, Best Weekly, Four Ball or ABCD.

Braemar has structured its prepayment program to include these benefits:

- A discount on per-round greens fees compared to standard rack rates
- A free 18-hole weekday round tied to your Players Card purchase
- Additional golf shop credits so each league can offer more pay-outs

Here's how prepayment will work:

- For Monday League, the prepayment amount, covering of a season of 18 weeks, will be \$344.08 per player (which includes tax).
- For Tuesday and Wednesday Leagues, the prepayment amount, covering a 17-week season, and where each player plays two weeks out of three, will be \$215 per player (which includes tax).
- For Thursday League, the prepayment amount, covering a season of 21 weeks, will be \$687.09 (which includes tax) for players who participate every week. For teams with more than four members, the prepayment amount will be pro-rated.
- Braemar's prepayment deadline is in April and Braemar will accept prepayments only from team captains, so each captain must collect prepayments from his team members and then will pay Braemar for their entire teams.
- Since prepayments aren't due to Braemar until later in the spring, you can join your favorite leagues right now, but if prepayment is required for a league of your choice, then league participation will depend on your making prepayment when due. If you fail to do so, you will not be allowed to participate as a league member.
- On any day during the season when you're unable to play as scheduled, find a substitute. If you can't identify someone, ask your team captain or league coordinator for help. Any greens fee reimbursements will be strictly between you and your substitute.
- Braemar will not provide rain checks to players who prepay. Rainouts will dilute the overall savings from discounted greens fees.
